Medications are injected or implanted into the eye to reverse blood vessel growth.

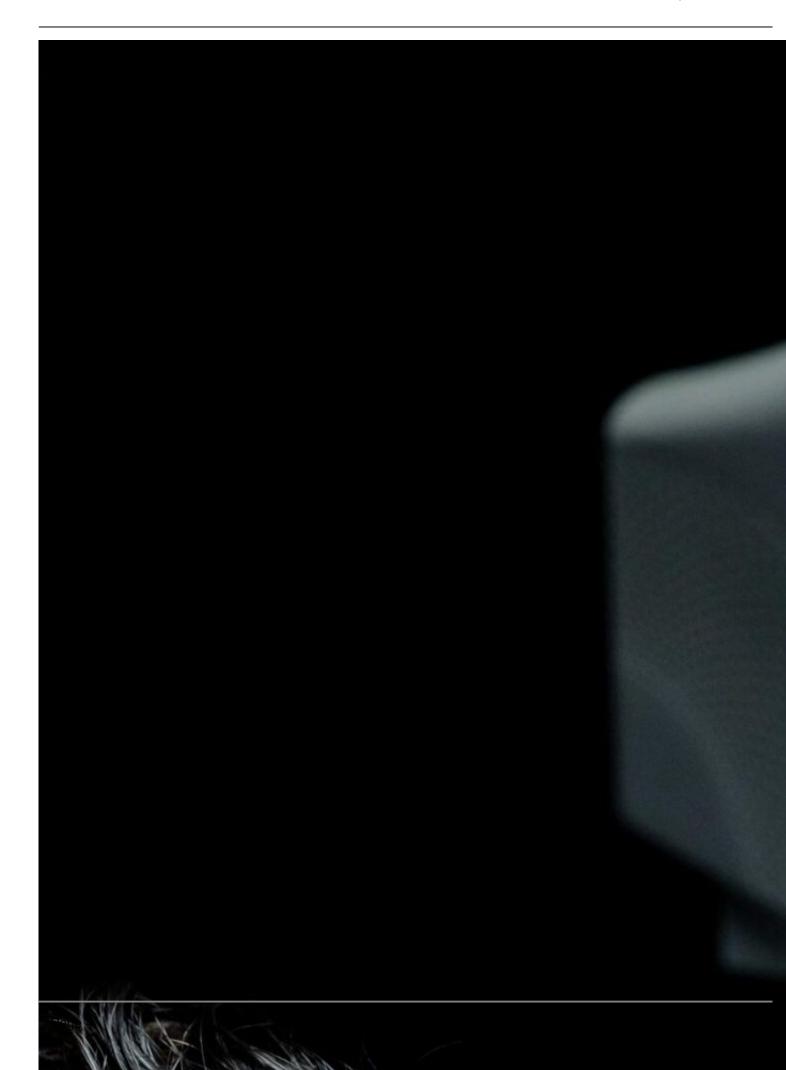
In laser surgery, leaking blood vessels are sealed utilizing a laser light, preventing more fluid from entering the macula.
